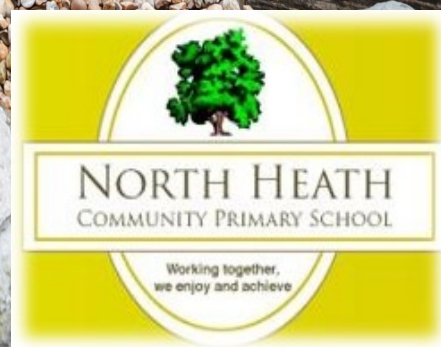

Our aim is to provide a happy and learning in a calm learning environment in which all pupils are supported. We offer a high standard of early education, ensuring pupils are motivated to new experiences, encouraging their natural curiosity.

Our large Reception classes and enclosed garden create a varied and stimulating environment, in which pupils can draw on their previous knowledge and skills to achieve their full potential in all areas of learning.

Dedicated staff provide for the individual needs and interests of all our pupils, involving them in decision making, thus encouraging independence. The children's journey through Reception prepares

Key Stage 1

Pupils progress from the Foundation Stage to Key Stage 1 (Years 1 and 2). A seamless transition is achieved by following the Foundation Stage style teaching and learning during the first few months of Year 1. This is followed by the teaching of the key areas of the National Curriculum such as reading, writing (including phonics and grammar), maths and science.

Throughout Key Stage 1, National Curriculum subjects are linked together creatively through topic based learning. We

make learning fun and interesting for our pupils through hands on activities, outdoor experiences, drama and play based learning.

Flexible teaching styles enable our pupils to develop and refine their skills. We aim to nurture a real enjoyment of

Throughout Key Stage 2, we work together to foster an enthusiasm for learning, enabling our pupils to realise their full potential. Within a purposeful learning environment, pupils benefit from a broad, balanced and stimulating curriculum, which incorporates a wide range of new technologies.

The experiences of our pupils are enriched by engaging topics. These are supported by a wide range of educational and residential trips, as well as external visitors and specialist teachers.
