Ofsted Inspection Report

North Heath Community Primary School remains a good school.

Following quality assurance, our most recent Ofsted report has been published on their website. It is always difficult for inspectors to condense their views of schools into a report due to the limited amount of text available to them. Verbal feedback to school governors at the end of an inspection often expands on the main points that appear in reports.

During our final feedback session, the inspector was keen to point out the following:

There are areas of exceptional practice in the school and staff feel proud to work here. They appreciate the support they get and the strategies employed to help address workload issues.

Reading is a strength of the school and is extremely well led. Pupils have access to a wide range of texts and vocabulary, which leads to secure reading skills.

The carefully planned curriculum, including wider opportunities such as fieldwork and orienteering, demonstrates aspiration and challenge. Subject leadership is strong, with a clear, ambitious vision for development. Pupil understanding extends beyond the national curriculum and staff check for gaps in knowledge, which are systematically addressed.

The approach to safeguarding is vigilant. Staff are fully aware of reporting procedures and the school acts quickly. Liaison with external agencies is rigorous.

Any cases of teasing or bullying are addressed quickly and the children are confident that they are safe in school. Pupils stated that staff help solve their problems and they feel supported. The PSHE Curriculum supports pupil wellbeing and their understanding of online safety. Pupils are happy in school and understand the rules.

Pupils enjoy their efforts being celebrated in the honour book assembly, can talk eloquently about how they welcome new pupils into our community and have a strong sense of equality.

The mathematics curriculum and progression in calculation is well embedded, with staff showing a good understanding of the steps in learning. Self-assessment has a positive impact on pupil confidence. Pupils like mathematics, have the materials they need to help their progress, and standards for times tables are high. Whilst there were areas of exceptional SEND practice, we do agree with Ofsted that provision for some SEND pupils could be more consistently matched with their needs. This fits well with an ongoing collaborative project we are taking part in with our locality group of schools. The report is attached for your information.
