Welcome Back

Firstly, a warm welcome back to you all and a special greeting to all new arrivals and those in Reception, who join us for the first time.

Inset days on Friday 1 September and Monday 4 September are being used to plan clubs, review policy content, organise timetables, work on a new format for SEND IPPs (with a focus on pupil voice) as well as safeguarding training. In addition, teachers are planning and preparing their curriculum for the arrival of pupils. In particular, they are embedding strategies to help pupils remember information as well as adapting our current writing journeys.

School Day

YR External Works

Progress on this has been less pleasing. Whilst the old shelter has been removed, the new shelter won't be in place for a couple of weeks. This part of the site will therefore be temporarily out of use, so Apple Class will need to enter and exit school through Plum Class.

Concrete News - A statement from WSCC

You will be aware of the national news surrounding concrete in some schools. Below is good news about school premises in West Sussex from WSCC:

'West Sussex County Council is aware of the RAAC issue and has already completed a review of records for WSCC maintained schools. No WSCC maintained schools have been identified from records as containing any indicating RAAC construction and to provide added confidence physical inspections of all maintained school blocks constructed between 1930-2000 is being commissioned.

We can confirm no West Sussex County Council maintained schools will be immediately shutting due to this issue.'
