- KIRFS (Key Instant recall facts) sent home half termly

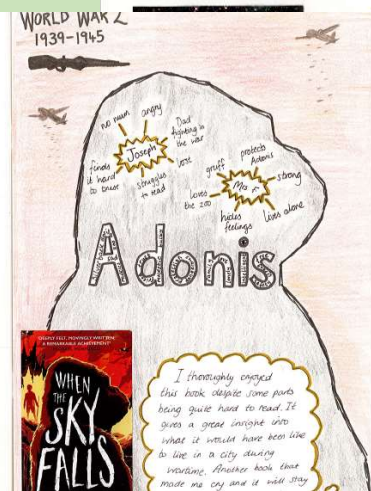
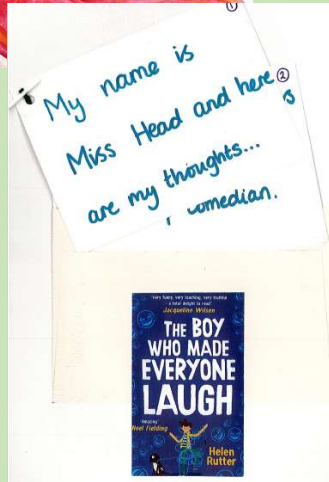
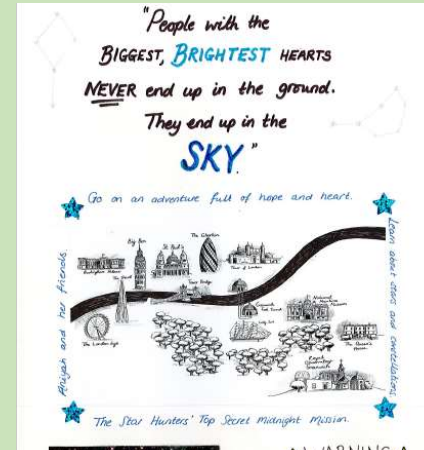
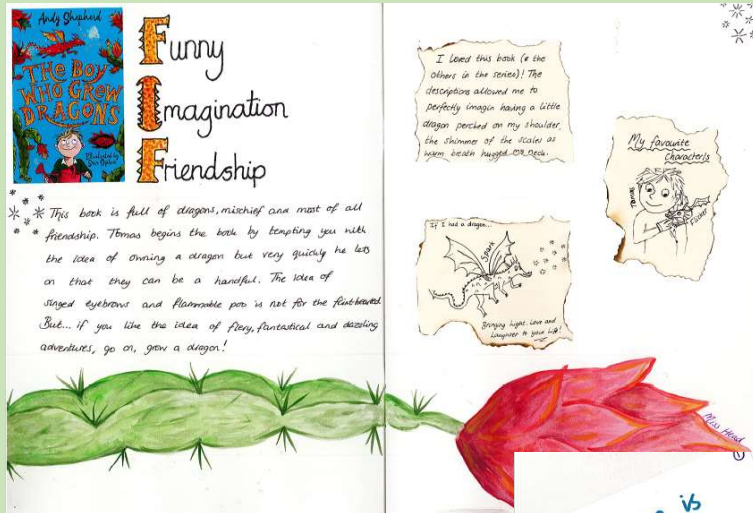
# Homework

- Weekly maths - Schofield and Sims booklets - 20 minutes

- Children will be given a homework diary to fill out

# P.E.

# Rewards and Sanctions



## House points:

- For recognition of positive behaviour in the classroom and around school; these points add into the whole school house point system

## Merits:

- Individual rewards for exemplary work and behaviour. Children will need to gain 44 Merits to achieve their Bronze award. Then it will be repeated for their Silver/Gold/Star Awards.
- Class charter - children come up with class rules based on what they feel/think will help to make their classroom a happy and safe space to learn!
- We have a behaviour policy which is a scaled approach to support children to make good decisions in school where necessary we will contact parents to discuss any concerns.
